- Commit to curatorial responsibilities from March to July 2020
- Identify the artists to be included in the exhibition.
- Identify the specific works to be included.
- Utilize Google Drive to organize and communicate with artists, writers and SYLA STUDIO.
- Work within the time-line provided for items to be completed to assure the proper publicity and timely opening of the exhibition.
- Provide the description necessary to use in marketing and social media
- With production support from SYLA STUDIO, the curator will select and arrange social media content, such as artist/curator interview posts, visual content, etc. relating to the exhibition.
